Yellow Shore Crab	<i>Hemigrapsus oregonensis</i>	rare, in <i>Enteromorpha</i> bed and in collection of neighbor
Purple Shore Crab	<i>Hemigrapsus nudus</i>	rare (dead crab found in collection of neighbor w)

Yellow Crab	<i>Cancer anthonyi</i>	said it was found in the park)
Black Clawed Crab	<i>Lophopanopeus belus</i>	occasional under rocks, mid to low tide zone
Dungeness Crab	<i>Cancer Magister</i>	rare: voucher specimen at CAS
Green Crab	<i>Carcinus maenas</i>	occasional under rocks, mid to low tide zone
Mud Crab	<i>Hemigrapsus oregonensis</i>	occasional under rocks, mid to low tide zone
Hermit Crab	<i>Unknown</i>	common, can tolerate sewage outflow
Bay Ghost Shrimp	<i>Callianassa californiensis</i>	uncommon under rocks
		common in holes in mudflats at east and west end of park
Ghost Shrimp Copepod	<i>Clausidium vancouverense</i>	common on bodies of <i>Callianassa</i>
Acorn Barnacle	<i>Balanus glandula</i>	abundant
Isopod	<i>Gnorimosphaeroma luteum</i>	under rocks
Western Sea Roach	<i>Ligia occidentalis</i>	abundant under rocks at high tide line
Common Sand Flea	<i>Atylopsis</i>	abundant under rocks at high tide line
Hairy-gilled Polychaete	<i>Cirriformia spirabrancha</i>	common in sand at west end of park
Mussel Worm	<i>Nerieis vexillosa</i>	occasional under rocks and in sand
Giant Mussel Worm	<i>Neanthes branti</i>	occasional under rocks and in sand
Ringed Spotted Dorid	<i>Diaulu sandiegensis</i>	rare, found at eastern edge of park under rocks
No common name	<i>Lamellaria sp.</i>	rare: voucher specimen at CAS
Club Tunicate	<i>Styela clava</i>	rare under rocks low time zone
Star Tunicate	<i>Botryllus sp.</i>	common under rocks
Colonial Tunicate	<i>Botrylloides sp.</i>	common under rocks
Tunicate	<i>Molgula manhattensis</i>	occasional under rocks
Native Oyster	<i>Ostrea lurida</i>	occasional on low intertidal rocks
Bay Mussel	<i>Mytilus edulis</i>	common on wharf pilings and low intertidal rocks
Bent-nosed Clam	<i>Macoma nasuta</i>	occasional in sand/mud flats
Soft-shelled Clam	<i>Mya arenaria</i>	occasional in sand/mud flats
False Mya	<i>Cryptomya californica</i>	occasional in ghost shrimp holes
